Bauple State School will receive

\$25,503*

This funding will be used to

- Ensure all Year 3 and Year 5 students achieve results that are at or above the National Minimum Standard within NAPLAN Reading (National Assessment Program: Literacy and Numeracy).
- Provide individual educational assistance for students in Prep – Year 6 at risk of not meeting National Minimum Standards (NMS) in Reading.

Our initiatives include

- Implement a whole school intensive reading support program (Daily Rapid Reading Program – Early Years and Literacy Circle – Senior Years), for students (Prep – Year 6) to develop individual student knowledge of reading strategies and increasing reading comprehension.
- Provide educational assistance and intensive literacy support for students in Prep – Year 6 to increase their student achievement reading.
- Implement a teaching staff focus on 'Short Term Data Cycles' to provide regular feedback on student progress in targeted learning areas (Reading Comprehension) – including teacher developed pre and post reading comprehension assessment (with the guidance from literacy coach and Head of Department Regional Services) and miscue analyses/running records, Fountas and Pinnell tests.


Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Allocating funding for the purchase of teacher and teacher aide resources to support the implementation of intervention for reading comprehension strategies. **\$8503**
- Employment of a teacher to support the implementation of a whole school intensive reading program; including the provision of Teacher Relief Scheme to allow teachers to work with literacy coach to mentor and support the whole school intensive reading program. **\$17000**
